## 2. Pre-Event

Maximum 2 teams per gender will be able to participate in each events as Wild Card. In principle, an athlete can receive a maximum of 2 Wild Cards, irrespective, if for the Main Draw or the Qualification Tournament during one season.

In principle, Wild Card allocations are at the discretion of JVA. JVA will take into consideration the promotional aspects, technical merits, athletes' career, satisfactory technical/status of the team, etc. to select the teams.

### ○ Entry Procedure

Athletes who wish to participate in the events email below items to the organizer by respective entry deadline.

- First name & last name (both players)
- FIVB# (both players)
- Height & Weight (both players)
- Which events you want to participate

After the deadline, the organizer will select the teams and email all teams the result. In order to confirm the participation, JVA will send invitation letter to his/her NF and receive declaration letter from his/her NF.

It is mandatory to bring a PCR negative certification tested 72 hours before departure. (as of July 6, 2022)

### 3. COMPETITION

○ Preliminary Inquiry

The preliminary inquiry is normally organized 1 day before the competition day used by online meeting (ZOOM).

Since it is conducted by only Japanese, the organizer will help and to inform you of the necessary information shared in the preliminary inquiry.

○ Technical Meeting

No technical meeting for all events is scheduled so far.

○ Training Principles & Availability

Official training will be secured for all participating teams 1 day before the event. 1 hour slot will be allocated for 1 team, but 2 hours booking may be possible if 2 teams train together.

The Organizer will ask in advance all teams by email to hear the preference of a training time.

○ Accreditation

Official accreditation will be provided to all athletes by the organizer, and will ensure that only those with appropriate accreditation can access the designated venue areas.

Please note that accreditation cards will be returned to the organizer at the end of each tournament.

○ Accommodation and Transportation

Athletes will be personally responsible for international flight, domestic transportation, hotel and meals.

In terms of acceptance of foreign tourists under covid-19 situation, Japanese Travel Agent needs to handle all the booking or transportation arrangement, except international flight.

- Mixed Zone, Press Conferences and Awarding Ceremony  
Athletes are required to attend mixed zone interviews, press conference (if organized) and awarding ceremony. Athletes are required to wear their competition uniform.

- Uniforms  
Playing tops/tanks will be provided to all athletes by the organizer. Shorts/bottoms and accessories are the responsibility of the players.  
If required by the organizer, shorts/bottom and accessories will be checked before the match. Athletes of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts.

## 5. QUALIFICATION PROCESS FOR TOUR FINAL IN OSAKA

A total of 6 teams per gender will participate in the Tour Final in Osaka from October 15 to 16. Teams will earn their place at the tournament as procedures set forth below and no wild card is allocated to the tour final.

- I. Teams who have won more than 2 tournaments in this season will be automatically qualified for the final.
- II. 5 teams per gender based on the Mynavi Japan Beach Volleyball Tour Points calculated on October 3 will be qualified for the final.
- III. Highest ranking team of JVA Points Ranking calculated on October 3 will be qualified for the final.
